The ILEF International Less Lethal Weapons database provides free access to original, open source material relating to less lethal weapons. The database is accessible over the Internet and initially available to law enforcement, government, military and research organisations who supply information for inclusion in the database.

The database was officially launched online at the 2005 International Law Enforcement Forum in Ottawa, Canada. The database is being well received within the industry and one year after launch, the database contained over 250 records supplied by 37 international organisations¹.

The International Less Lethal Weapons Database was developed by the UK Home Office Scientific Development Branch (HOSDB) in response to recommendations made by the International Law Enforcement Forum (ILEF), UK Association of Chief Police Officers (ACPO), and the European Working Group on Non-Lethal Weapons (EWG-NLW).
